Information for **chaperones** about the Harbor Dance Cruise on Saturday, May 15th

Thank you for volunteering to chaperone. There are some items regarding safety and accountability listed below. Thank you for adhering to them responsibly, so everyone has a fun and safe time.

Transportation: Bus transportation is being provided for all students, their guests and chaperones for this event. This is to ensure proper supervision and boarding of the ship. ***ALL students, their guests and chaperones MUST ride the bus TO and FROM the event to board the ship.***

There are four buses and each bus is assigned by grade according to space. Chaperones are assigned to buses also. To avoid confusion, once riders have checked in and boarded the buses, they are not allowed off. Chaperones must spread out on the bus rides to insure proper supervision.

Departure: ***The buses will depart AMSA at 5:30pm sharp.*** Parents should drop off their children between 5:00 to 5:15 at the AMSA parking lot for check-in and to board the buses.

If someone assigned to your bus has not arrived by 5:15, call the phone number given on the permission slip.

Return: The buses will return to AMSA at approximately 10:45 pm. ***Parents should plan to be at AMSA by 10:30 to pick up their children.***

Students should call parents after boarding the return bus to remind them of pick up. You are responsible for all riders assigned to your bus. Two chaperones must stay with the students on your bus until they have all been picked up by their parents.

Harbor Cruise: We will board Mass Bay Lines' *Freedom* at 6:30pm. Dinner, soft drinks and a DJ are included in the cost. *No alcoholic drinks will be served to anyone.* No food or drink may be brought on board the ship.

No one will be served alcohol, including chaperones.

Dress: The students have requested that the dress for this event be semi-formal. Please use your best judgment in your attire. The ship will be moving and has multiple levels. Shoes with traction are recommended. Spring evenings on Boston Harbor can be chilly, please dress appropriately.

Bring a sweater or jacket just in case.

Conduct: The charter reserves the right to refuse to board anyone whose conduct is determined to be a detriment to the group order, or to the safety of the vessel, or anyone on board.

The charter will return to port if someone is not behaving appropriately. If there is an issue, please find an AMSA representative for resolution to avoid ending the cruise for everyone.

Chaperones are to: watch students so there is no coupling or isolation, patrol the railing in your area, and check bathrooms.
