

Community Service at AMSA

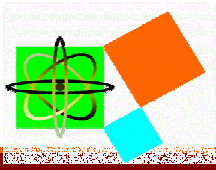


Yes, community service is a graduation requirement at AMSA. Effective July 1, 2009, a minimum of 10 community service hours per school year (including summer) for grades 9 - 12 is required for graduation. Students completing 25 hours or more of community service in one given school year are eligible for recognition at the end of that school year. AMSA's community service year runs from July 1st - June 30th.

Community Service Confirmation Forms can be found in the upper school lobby.

Community Service activities must conform to the following guidelines:

- Service must be performed without compensation to the student.
- Court-ordered community service will not be accepted.
- Service receiving academic or honors credit will not be accepted.
- Service must benefit at least one person other than the student or the student's relative(s).
- Service cannot be used to earn credit for more than one program or organization.
- A complete and legible Community Service Confirmation Form must be submitted to the Office of the Registrar at the Advanced Math and Science Academy Charter School.
