

## AMSA Supply List--Grades 9-12: 2010-2011

Students in grades 9-12 are expected to know how best to organize their work. Basic supplies are routine items needed by all students. Students should have a binder or notebook and folder for each subject including electives. Students may use binders or notebooks as they prefer unless otherwise specified by the subject teacher. Some teachers may require additional supplies at the beginning of the school year. Use sale days to purchase extra items like loose-leaf paper, pencils, notebooks, etc., and save for later in the year.
