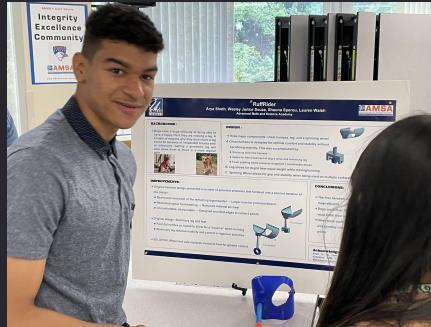
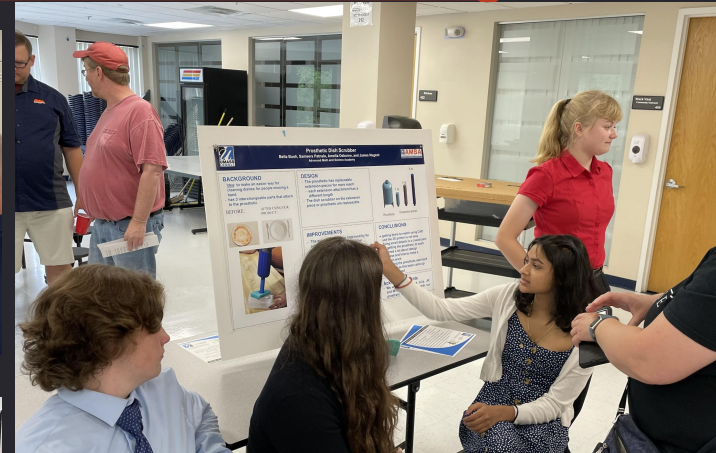
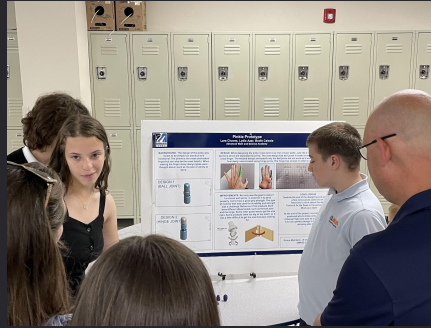

## The Facts:

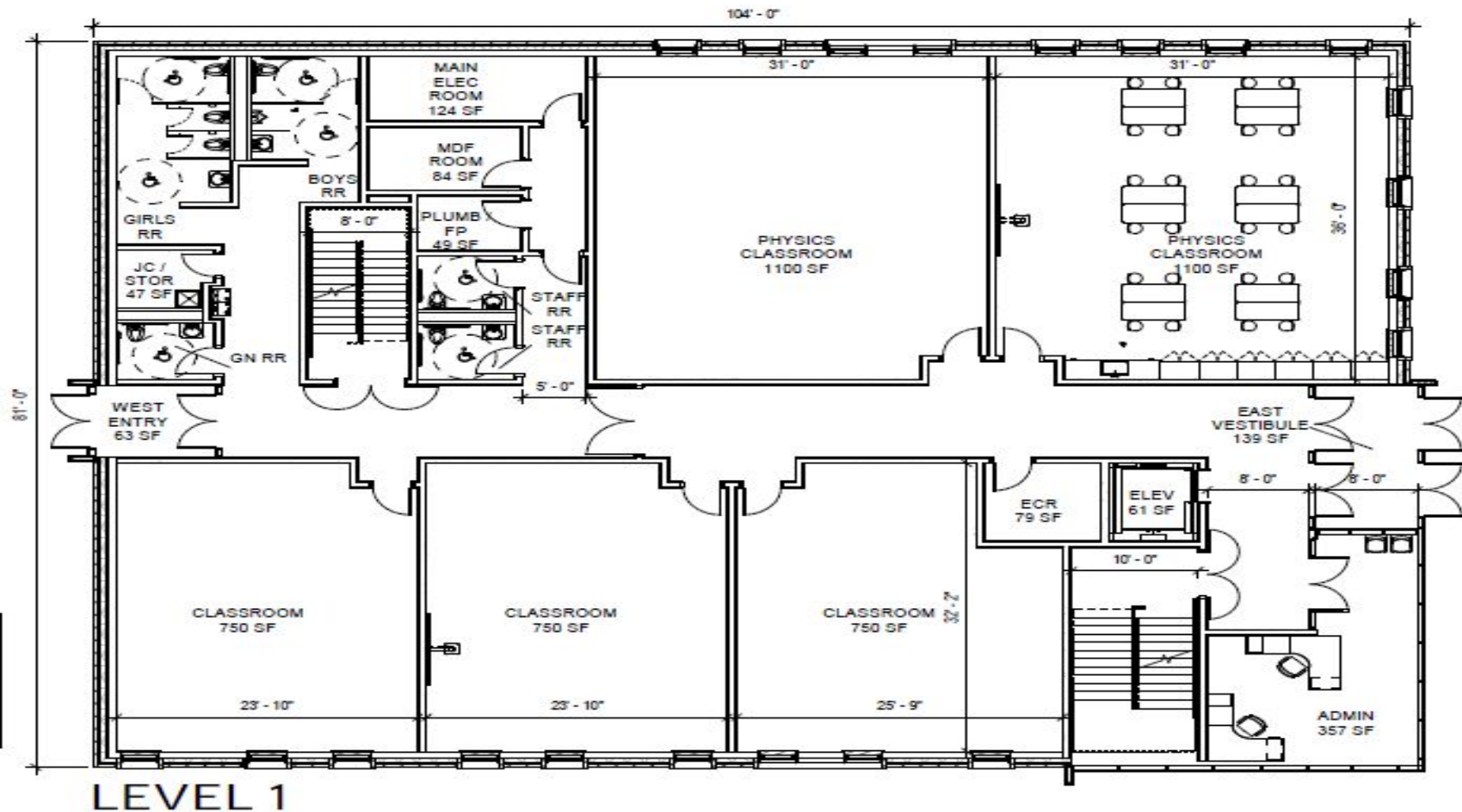
- The construction project has gone through 3 re-designs in the last 9 months
- Cost is the driving force behind the changes
- Size of the project and our expectations have had to adjust
- Timeline to break ground has moved to the Summer of 2023
- Completion of the new Academic Building is August 2024

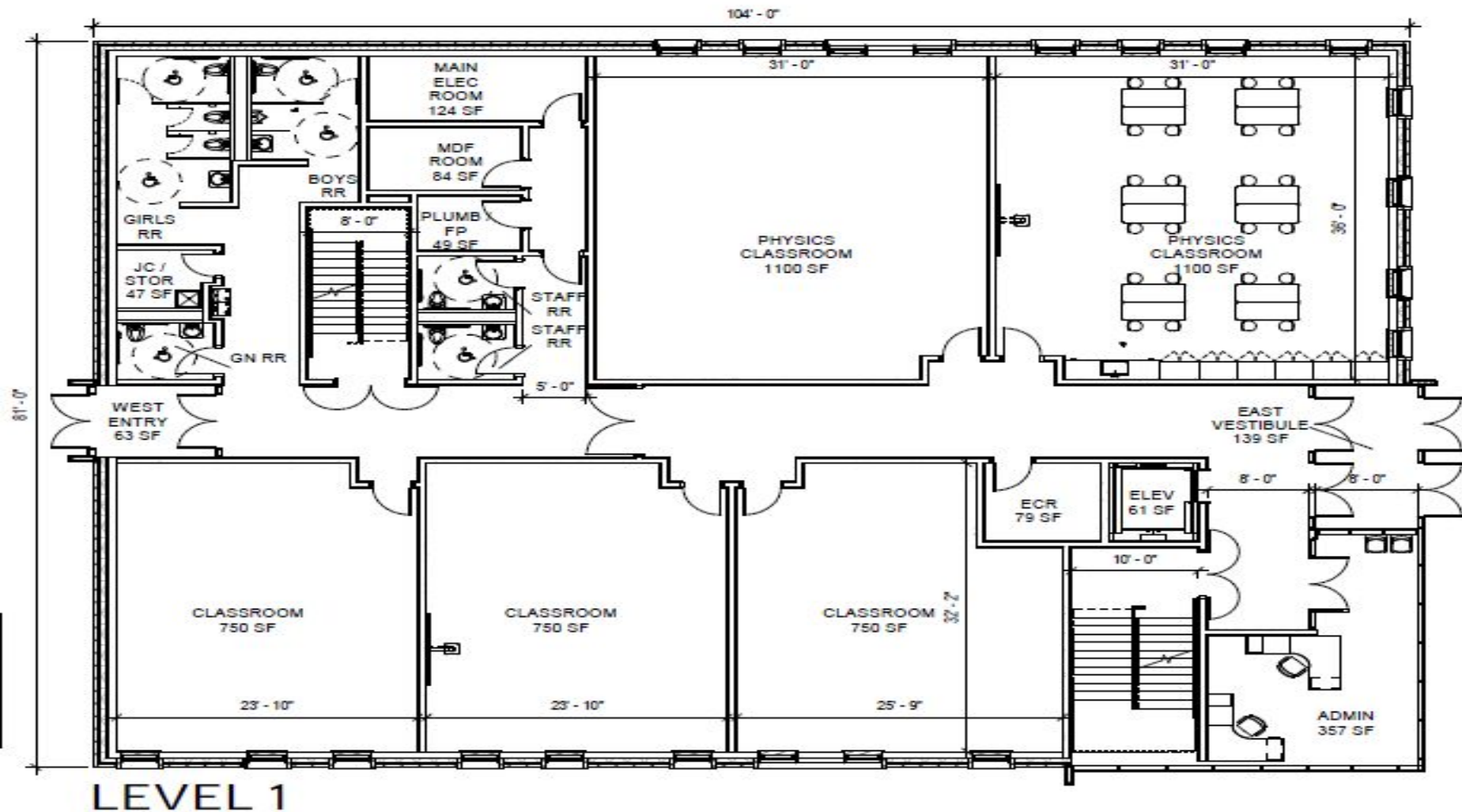
## The Current Plan:

- ***New Academic Building and Traffic Pattern changes***
- ***17,000 sqft. with a plan to eventually connect a gym (phase 2)***
- ***5 new labs + 5 new classrooms = 10 additional classrooms***
